New Required Item For New York State Energy Code Compliance

In order to help ensure compliance with the Energy Conservation Construction Code of New York State (ECCCNYS), a new required item called the “ECCCNYS compliance statement” will automatically apply to all New Building applications.

Effective November 15, one of the following statements must appear on your plan:

“To the best of my knowledge, belief and professional judgment, these plans and specifications are in compliance with the Energy Conservation Construction Code of New York State, using Chapter _____ [specify chapter].”

If a project is exempt from the ECCCNYS, the following statement must be included on the plan:

“To the best of my knowledge, belief and professional judgment, these plans and specifications are exempt from the Energy Conservation Construction Code of New York State because _____ of _____ [provide explanation], per Chapter 1, Section _____ [specify section].”

Remember, even if a required item is not triggered on every application, all applications must comply with the Energy Conservation Construction Code of New York State.
